Get Ready for Summer Reading!

School is out, which means it is officially time for our adult and children's summer reading programs to begin! We have lots of fantastic prizes this year for adults and children alike, including roll up blankets, bags, and tablet holders for adults as well as several toys for the kids!

This year's summer reading theme is "It's Showtime at Your Library." As such, we will be emphasizing public performance, movies, and the theatre in both our programming as well as our signage.

As usual, the summer reading program will last from June 1st to August 1st, with one prize being given to patrons who successfully meet their reading goal each and fill out their reading log each week. In addition to our weekly summer reading prizes for patrons that meet their weekly reading goals, this year we will also be holding a raffle for patrons who check out materials during the months of June and July. Participants are eligible to win two new tablets as well as a \$200 gift card to Target courtesy of First American Bank. For each book checked out, the patron will receive one raffle ticket. Additionally, participants will be able to have the number of tickets they earn multiplied if they refer a new patron to sign up for a library card. A final drawing will be held at North Chicago Community Day. If the winner is present, he or she will win a bonus prize, otherwise the winner will be notified via phone. Anime Club: Pizza and a Movie

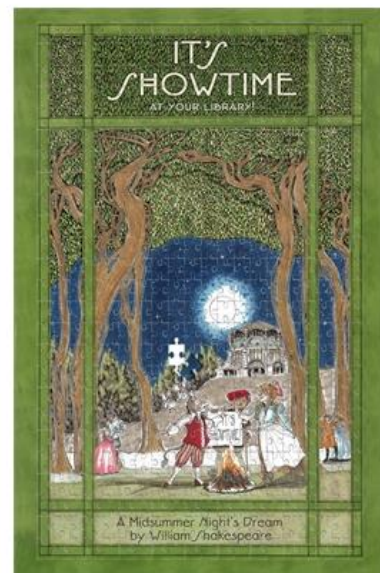
Tuesday, June 25th, 4:00PM-6:00PM
