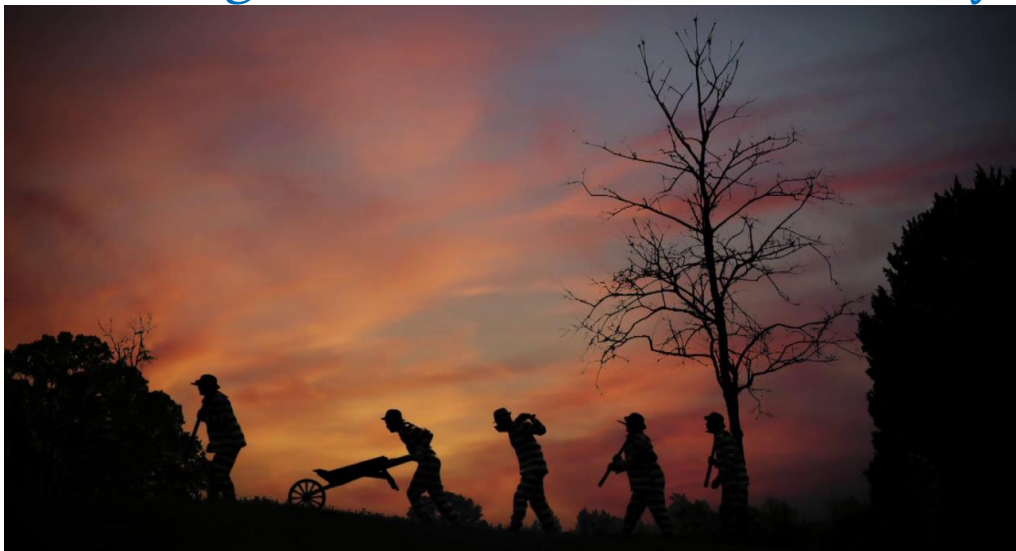

Focusing on African American History



Black History Month Events and More at NCPL

It's Black History Month, and North Chicago Public Library will be observing African American history with several programs and events. For adults, we'll be showing the acclaimed documentaries *Freedom Riders* and *Slavery by Another Name*. *Freedom Riders* tells the story of the Civil Rights Movement interstate busing campaign as it traveled through the Deep South for six months in 1961 purposefully violating Jim Crow laws as a form of nonviolent protest. *Slavery by Another Name* documents how slavery persisted in practice after its abolishment via convict labor and other government practices from 1865 to 1941. For children, we'll be showing a short documentary on President Obama on President's Day. If you're interested in attending either documentary showing, please turn to our schedule of events on page three to see the dates and times that the documentaries will be screened. During March, we'll have the privilege of hosting the Project 2-3-1 exhibit produced by the Elgin History Museum! Designed to complement the documentary, the exhibit showcases the history of Elgin, Illinois's black community from 1862 when 110 freed slaves made a three block area of Elgin their home. The exhibit will be located in the adult section of the library for the entirety of March, so patrons may browse the exhibit at their leisure during regular library hours. The Project 2-3-1 documentary will also be shown. Please check the schedule of library events on page three for further details.
