

## 3D Print Request at the North Chicago Public Library

The North Chicago Public Library is so excited to accept 3D print projects! Please read and fill out the form below to get started!

**3D Printing is only available to NCPL cardholders.**

### **3D Print Requirements and Information:**

- Projects will be completed in the order that they are submitted.
- Print must be in .STL format. Any other format will not be accepted. Please email your .STL file to [leahm@ncplibrary.org](mailto:leahm@ncplibrary.org).
- Our MakerBot Replicator + can print up to 11.2" (L) x 6.0" (W) x 6.1" (H). Please ensure that your model will fit on the printing bed.
- The MakerBot Replicator + can only print models in **one color at a time**.

### **How much does it cost?**

- The North Chicago Public Library charges .10¢ per gram. Before printing, we will put the file through the MakerBot slicer, which will estimate the time it will take to print and how many grams of filament it will use.
- Payment is required at the time of pickup.

### **Policy**

- For multi-part prints, patrons are required to make separate requests for each part.
- The library staff reserves the right to refuse any 3D Print request.
- The public will not be permitted to use the library's equipment and tools to create material that is:
  - Prohibited by local, state, or federal law
  - Unsafe, harmful, dangerous, or poses an immediate threat to the well-being of others
  - We cannot print any weapons, items that look like or can be used as a weapon, or weapon parts.
  - Obscene or otherwise inappropriate for the library environment
  - In violation of another's intellectual property rights
