

3D Print Request at the North Chicago Public Library

The North Chicago Public Library is excited to accept 3D print projects! Please read and fill out the form below to get started!

3D Printing is only available to NCPL cardholders.

3D Print Requirements and Information:

- Projects will be completed in the order that they are received.
- Print must be in STL format. Any other format will not be accepted. Please email your .STL file to leahm@ncplibrary.org.
- Our Bambu P1S can print up to 256mm x 256mm x 256mm. Please ensure that your model will fit on the printing bed.
- Although the Bambu P1S is able to print multiple colors, patrons are limited to one color for each print.

How much does it cost?

- The North Chicago Public Library charges .10c per gram.
- Before printing, the file will be processed through the Bambu Labs slicer, which will estimate the time it will take to print and how many grams of filament it will use.
- Payment is required at the time of pickup.

Policy

- For multi-part prints, patrons are required to make separate requests for each part.
- We reserve the right to refuse any 3D print request.
- Patrons will not be permitted to use the library's equipment/tool to create material that is:
 - Prohibited by local, state, or federal law
 - Unsafe, harmful, dangerous, or poses an immediate threat to the well being of others
 - Weapons, items that look like or can be used as a weapon, or weapon parts
 - Obscene or otherwise inappropriate for the library environment
 - In violation of another's intellectual property rights
